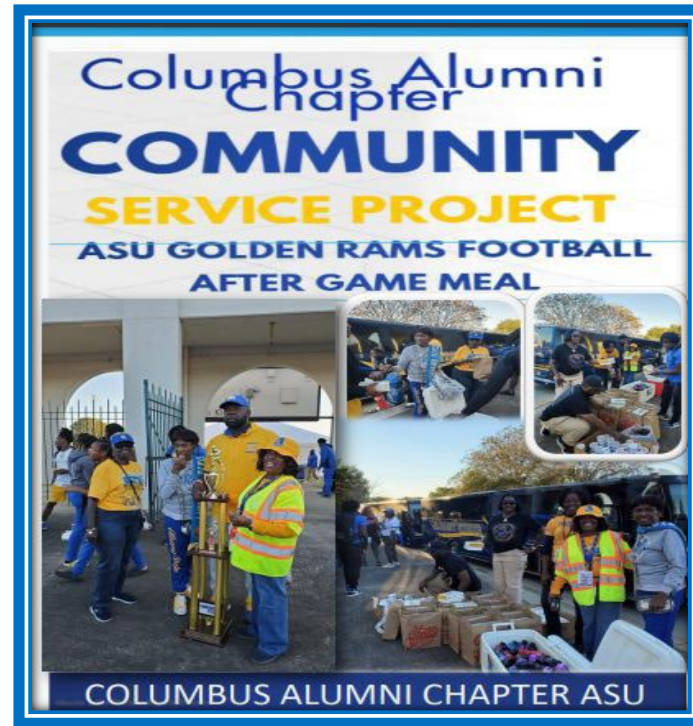
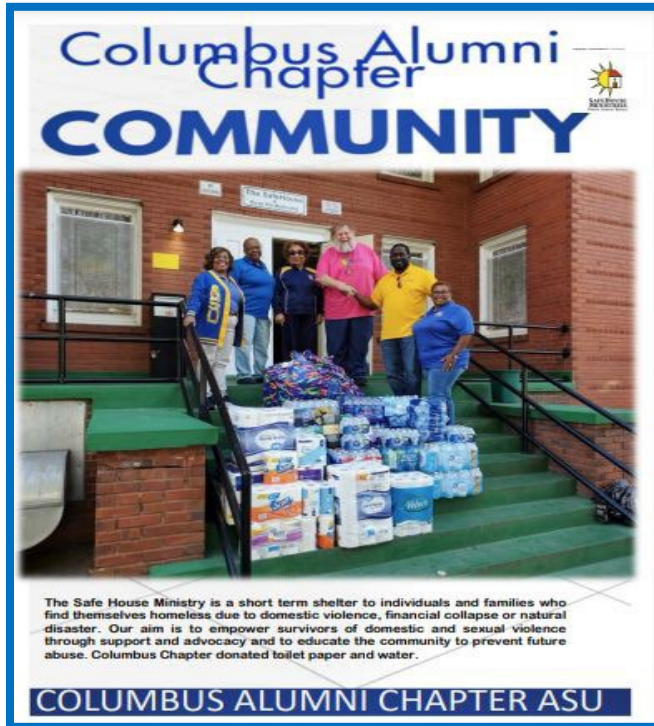
SALVATION ARMY BELL RINGING EFFORT

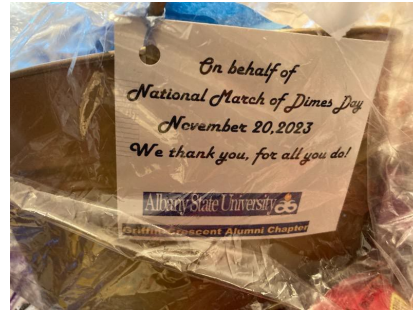
