** FUNDRAISER INITIATIVES **

We kicked off the year with the Fundraising Initiative - \$1 Million in 1 Year for ASU...I'm All In! The goal of this initiative is to encourage support from all ASU alumni to increase the overall population of alums who give back to the university. The plan for this initiative will include various virtual and social media campaigns throughout the year.

- Since all 2020 Homecoming events were canceled, the Fundraising Kick-Off Homecoming RAM
 -Bucks Rally, asked donors to contribute anticipated expenses to the Alumni Endowment Scholarship Fund.
- In celebration of Black History Month, we launched the "I Love My HBCU" campaign seeking 1,051 alumni to donate \$19.03 in the month of February to raise \$20,000. (TEXT TO GIVE: ASUNAA TO 41444)
- Other significant campaigns that are forthcoming in the near future are **500** for **\$500** and **1,000** for **\$100**.
- We also implemented the **Greek Challenge** which will culminate at the end of the year. The committee is planning to host a **virtual event**, possibly during the time frame of Albany State Founder's Day or later in the summer.
- We established a give back partnership with the HBCU paraphernalia company Legacy, History, Pride and The Rocket Restaurant in Albany, GA.
- The ASUNAA Board of Directors has partnered with the ASU Foundation to reach the broader alumni database and streamline the giving process using Mobile Cause.

** LISTENING SESSIONS SCHEDULED FOR CHANCELLOR SEARCH **

The Regents Search Advisory Group has scheduled listening sessions to receive input from students, faculty, staff and the public on its search for the next Chancellor of the University System of Georgia.
